(Set #1) God's Purpose for People Doesn't Change

- **Genesis 1:28** *"And God blessed them. And God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth.'"*
- **Genesis 9:1-2** *"And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth. The fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth and upon every bird of the heavens, upon everything that creeps on the ground and all the fish of the sea. Into your hand they are delivered.'"*
- **Matthew 28:19-20** *"And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'"*

(Set #2) God Shows Patience for Sinners

- **1 Peter 3:20** *"...when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water."*
- **2 Peter 2:5** *"if he did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a herald (or preacher) of righteousness, with seven others, when he brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly"*
- **Romans 1:19-20** *"For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse."*
- **2 Peter 3:9** *"The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance."*

(Set #3) Our Response in Faith

- **Genesis:** (6:8) First, Noah receives unmerited favor. (6:10) Then, we learn that Noah walks with God. (7:5) Then we learn Noah does all that God commanded him to do (instructions for building the ark). (8:6-14) Noah waits expectantly and acts in faith that God would restore the earth.
- **Hebrews 11:7** *"By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith."*
- **Romans 5:19** *"For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous."*
- **1 John 2:6** *"whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked."*
