

Small Group Questions

1. Genesis 28:10-22, John 1:47-51

How can you live or think differently this week because God, through Jesus, has come and provided a way to heaven?

2. Genesis 29:1-30, Psalm 7:16, 1 John 1:8-10

Do you see God's providence in your everyday life? What have you seen? Are you thankful for it?

Do you have a familial or besetting sin? How can you fight it today; this week?

3. Genesis 29:31 - 30:24, Luke 12:4-7

Do you feel useless or unworthy because you do not have what our culture values? What in this passage can be an encouragement to one who feels the same?

4. Genesis 30:25-43, John 3:16, 1 Timothy 6:18-19

What do you love more than Jesus? How can you be generous this week with what you value?

5. Genesis 31:1-30, Luke 9:23-27

Why does Laban really pursue Jacob and his family?

What are you unwilling to part with today, e.g. stop worshipping, to obey Jesus for the kingdom of God? How can you be willing to part or actually part with that idol?

6. Genesis 31:31-42, 1 John 5:18, Heb 13:5-6

How has God protected you? What can you do or not do out of reliance on God's protection of you?

7. Genesis 31:43-55, Ps 34:14, Mark 1:15

Who does Laban swear by in the agreement? Who does Jacob swear by?

What is your habit of repentance and forgiveness?

How do you resolve conflict with those of this world? Do you pretend to be of the same religion to accomplish your goal?
