1. Read Hebrews 12: 1-17. How can we keep each other from falling away from our faith as Esau did?
2. As we look at Romans 9:6-16 in connection with our Genesis study today, what might we learn about God's sovereignty?
3. How did God's message to Rebekah about her sons in 25:23 compare to the wisdom and norms of her culture? I Corinthians 1:18-31 is a related passage. How might we use it to encourage a believer who feels insignificant to God?
4. In what areas of our lives are we tempted to doubt that God will fulfill His promises?
5. In what ways does grace take even our sin and use it for God's glory and our good?
6. If those around us start to notice that God is with us, what might a good response be?
7. If possible, describe a situation where you may have thought that you should not have been blessed by God, but you were anyway. How did it feel?
